The training course

The aims of this training course are:

- to better understand the origins and forms of far-right nowadays, the impacts of hate speech and far-right narratives and what are their roots
- to share good practices on how to tackle this issue in youth settings
- to provide tools and knowledge on how to take action, campaigning and advocating against inequalities and discrimination and to promote human rights.

- Workshops on the system of oppression
- Visit of a local initiative
- Sharing good practices
- Local action in the participants countries
- Digital storytelling

The methodology

- create a temporary community helping each other to learn in an inclusive and fun way

- Involvement in the community life and taking care of the place (with daily tasks)
- Non-formal education tools

These methods aim to develop critical thinking, sense of analysis and the capacity to share our opinion with others.

The place of the training course

The training course will take place in **Saint Lizier** (09200), in a holiday cottage called "**Au pays des traces**". You can find more info about the place <u>here</u>.

The hosting venue offers 3 dormitory rooms (one for women, one mixed and one for men) with 8 beds, 1 common bathroom space with 3 privates showers and toilets, a kitchen with dining room, an activity room and beautiful outdoors for activities (if the weather allows).

5-min walk from shops and laundry service 5-min walk from Saint Lizier historical center 15 min walk from Saint Girons city center Surrounded by nature

Please note that there is no WI-FI at the venue place











How to come to the venue

You will have to come to "**Toulouse**", which is the closest city to us (**Barcelona** is not so far away from us too). And then come to "**Boussens**" where we will pick you up with the vans to go to the place of the training course.

If you come by plane, the closest airport is "<u>Toulouse-Blagnac Airport</u>".

From the airport

Look at the info on the airport website. The name of the train station is "Marengo-SNCF". If you want to see a map of the public transport in Toulouse, you can look at Tisseo.



You can easily come by bus or train, which is usually not so expensive.

Toulouse train station

To catch a train to **Boussens**, you will have to go to the main train station of Toulouse called "**Toulouse-Matabiau**" or "**Marengo-SNCF**". If you arrive by train or bus, you are probably already at the good place. The Bus station is next to the train station.





To Boussens:

Take a train in the direction of

"Montréjeau", "Saint-Gaudens" or "Tarbes-Lourdes"



→ Check that **Boussens** is among the stops just in case... When you buy your ticket (at a counter or a machine) you can get a **25% discount** if you are **younger than 26** or you are a **student (possible online discount)**

Please pay attention!

- You should arrive to Toulouse on the 16th of September at
 16:00 (CEST) the latest
- You should take the train from Toulouse to Boussens at 17:36.

 There won't be any other time to pick you up!
- The departure from Toulouse on the 27th of September no earlier than 10:30 AM



To Saint Lizier/ Au pays des traces :

Once in "Boussens", there will be someone picking you up for the last step of your journey: a minivan ride!





Green travel and transport costs

When possible, we really want to **promote green travel** (travelling to and from the training course without taking any plane). We think it makes sense with our **ecological values**.

Of course, some countries are closer, so it's more doable, and it's in these cases that we would really want to **work together to help the participants to use this green travel.**

There is a **flat rate to reimburse participants** of their transport according to the number of kilometers. In the case where people use only green travels, there is a **50€ extra to cover additional costs** (a night in a hostel and a meal).

About the reimbursement: Participants have to buy the tickets, and we will then reimburse them (if this is not possible, please contact us). We always do our best to make **the reimbursement within 2 to 3 months** after the training. 6 months after will be our very maximum.

We will **reimburse the exact amount of the travel costs** if the costs are less than the rate. If it is exceeded, the participant will have to pay the difference. We can reimburse participants directly or the partner organization (we can discuss this together before the project with each partner).

PARTICIPANTS HAVE TO KEEP ALL THE TICKETS FROM THE TRAVEL.

(if not we won't be able to make the reimbursement)

Ask for an invoice/receipt for each of your travel tickets and keep them all carefully for us !!!

Keep also your boarding passes!

We need to see the place of departure, place or arrival, the time and your name.

Be careful with Ryanair app, they delete the boarding pass after the flight so download it before!

There is also a <u>youth hostel</u> in Toulouse. The price is 25.80 €/person/night.
